1. **This matter came before the Court:** On the stipulations of the parties, as shown by the signatures below.
2. **Findings.** The court considered the affidavit and stipulations
 - A. Irreconcilable differences have caused the irremediable breakdown of this marriage.
 - B. At the time the *Petition* was filed both spouses lived in Oregon and they had lived in Oregon continuously for 6 months prior to the filing of the *Petition*. At least one spouse lived in the county in which the *Petition* was filed.
 - C. No other domestic relations suit or support proceeding involving this marriage is pending in this or any other state.
